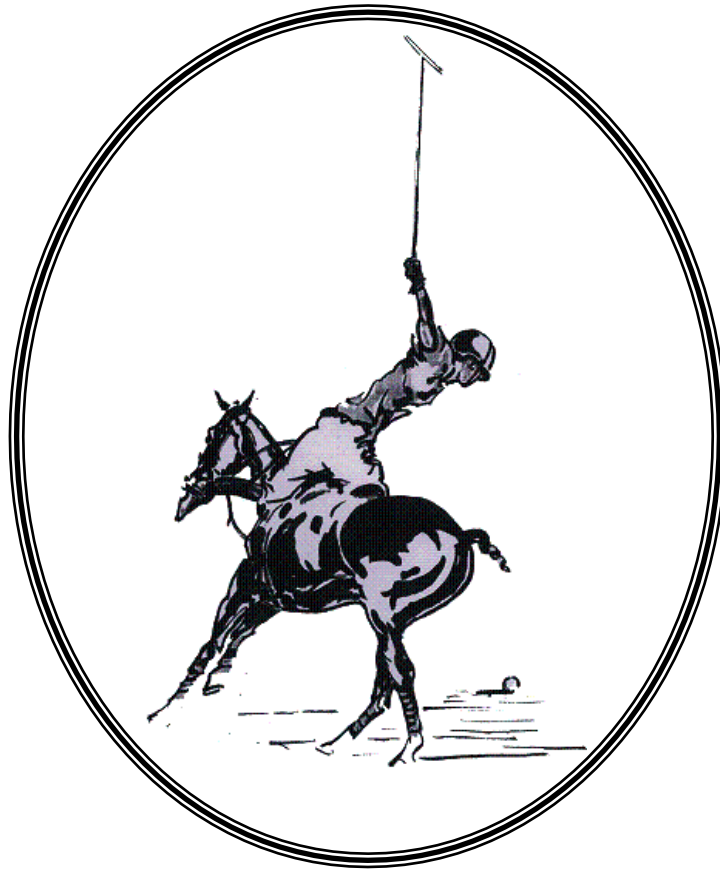

# **PROSPECTUS**

## JAIPUR POLO SEASON : 2017

1. Jaipur Polo Season is scheduled from 25 Sep 2017 to 07 Oct 2017. The following tournaments will be conducted :-

- (a) Sapta Shakti Cup (2 Goals/Teams will be made out of players not finding a team).
- (b) Chinkara Polo Cup (10 Goals).
- (c) Army Cdr's Polo Cup (10 Goals).

2. **Tournaments.** The tentative dates for tournaments are as under, subject to last minute unavoidable changes:-

3. **Venue.** The matches will be played at the 61 Cavalry Polo Grounds No 1 & 2, Jaipur. The schedule of matches has been fixed as per Para 2 above, However, all rights are reserved with the organizing committee to change time and dates depending upon the administrative reasons, ground conditions, balance of play, weather, security & safety aspects etc which will dictate the final date and timings of all matches( incl finals).

4. **Membership of IPA.** The above tournaments are open to teams whose players are members of a club or association, affiliated to the IPA and where annual subs have been credited to the IPA. It is the duty of the Manager or Captain to ensure that all members of the team fulfill this condition, failing which the team is liable to be disqualified at any stage.

5. **Registration of Ponies with IPA.** It is requested to get polo ponies registered with IPA at the earliest. Polo ponies not registered with IPA will not be able to participate in the tournament. Teams are liable to be disqualified if having played to non registered pony.

6. **Handicaps of Foreign Players.** Handicaps of foreign players will be verified by the team, they play for. In addition, the foreign players need to carry proof of their handicap. All foreign players participating in the Jaipur Polo Season will be charged Rs 1000/- towards playing member subscription as per the IPA letter No IPA/37 dt 5<sup>th</sup> Dec 1998. Foreign players whose clearance is not obtained will not be permitted to play.

7. **Rules.** All tournament will be played under IPA rules & guidelines.
8. **Chukkers.**
- (a) **Duration and No of Chukkers.** The tournaments shall be of 4 chukkers of 7 ½ minutes each.
- (b) **Intervals Between the Chukkers.** Duration of intervals allowed under IPA Rule G 9 (a) will be strictly adhered to (ie 3 minutes between chukkers and 5 minutes at half time). Umpires will start the game immediately after the interval, notwithstanding weather all players are present on the field or not. The timekeeper will run the clock for each chukker to display the interval duration.
9. **Entry Fee.** Team entry fees will be paid by local cheque/DD (payable at Jaipur) / cash in favours of Polo Fund, 61 Cavalry :-

10. **Eligibility.**
- (a) For a team to be eligible & for the entry to be accepted by the CPC (Chinkara Polo Club), the names of at least three members of the team will have to be given alongwith the entry being forwarded and total handicap of those three players must qualify the team to be eligible for the particular tournament.
- (b) **Minimum Handicap.** No team with less than 6 goals from the maximum handicap of the tournament would be allowed to participate.
11. **Date of Submission of Entries.** All entries of teams participating should reach the Polo Secy, 61 Cavalry before **20 Sep 2017** for CPC (Chinkara Polo Cup) and **22 Sep 2017** for ACPC (Army Cdr's Polo Cup) alongwith names of players duly authenticated by the management committee of the participants club. All terms and conditions will be signed by the team captain.
12. **Camp.** Camping areas will be specified on ground, however camping facilities will be made under arrangement of respective teams, Permission to stable horses during the forthcoming Jaipur Polo Season 2017 is subject to submission of duly completed application form specimen of which are attached.

13. **Stabling.**

(a) **Administration.** Local administration will be under overall supervision of 61 Cavalry. Orders of 61 Cavalry shall be final and no representation will be entertained. However, the participating teams are responsible for setting up their camp. In case assistance is required, please contact the Polo Secy to make arrangement in advance. This facility will be available for use by teams/players from **15 Sep 2017 to 15 Oct 2017**. The horse owner/club is required to furnish the following details as per Appx 'A' and 'B'.

- (i) List of participating horses.
- (ii) Valid coggins and glanders test certificates, with minimum 25 days validity on arrival till exit of horses.
- (iii) Passport as issued by IPA.

(b) **Security.** The 61 Cavalry Polo lines is located on defense land, hence there is a need to be extra cautious on the aspects of security. All defense/Para Military contingents, private horse owners and club members are hereby instructed to strictly adhere to the laid down rules and regulations. Any violation of these instructions would render the concerned contingent liable to be asked to vacate the camping and stabling premises forthwith.

(c) **General Instructions.**

- (i) No one will tap electricity and water.
- (ii) No one will throw used hay and litter in open areas. Areas will be specifically earmarked for this purpose.
- (iii) No firewood shall be used for cooking, only Kerosene or LPG shall be used.
- (iv) Daily Order of the Camp-in-Charge will be followed. Each stabling team will detail one person for taking orders.
- (v) The 61 Cavalry reserves the right to order all men to work for collective area cleaning as per following timings :-
  - (aa) 1000 hrs to 1145 hrs.
  - (ab) 1830 hrs to 1915 hrs.
- (vi) Riding areas will be earmarked separately.
- (vii) No Riding /exercising/grazing of horses is permitted inside the Polo grounds.

(d) **Discipline.** Consumption of liquor inside the complex is strictly prohibited. Defaulters will be severely penalized. Any case of assault or affray will be viewed very seriously and will result in the individual being expelled immediately.

(e) **Jurisdiction .** The responsibility as of safety of men, equipment, material and horses will be of the resp teams / clubs. No claim shall be made / entertained against the Chinkara Polo Club.

(f) **Security Deposit.** All contingent temporarily stabling at the Polo Lines (61 Cavalry) will pay refundable security deposit prior to setting up camp. The amount will be refunded after inspecting the Polo Line by OIC Camp on termination of the tournament. The security deposit is as follows :-

14. **Draws.** The draw will be conducted by the tournament committee at least 24 hours before the commencement of the tournament at the Heritage Centre, 61 Cavalry. Captains to be present for the draw. The committee reserves the right to seed teams if they feel it is desirable. In case, two teams are entered under the same name and request for placing in two different halves, same shall be considered. Draws will be conducted by the Tournament Coordinators in presence of team Captains, with the office bearers and staff of the Chinkara Polo Club.

15. **Contact Nos.** On arrival, all team captains are requested to contact the Polo Secy, 61 Cavalry on Mobile No **9214303902** or Army No - 6350.

16. **Objections.** All objection or any point which arise that are not covered by the above rules will be referred to the Polo Tournament Committee alongwith a non-refundable sum of Rs 2500/-. Their decision will be final.

17. **Withdrawal of Teams from Tournament.** No team is permitted to withdraw / give walk over once the lots for the draw for any tournament have been drawn. Teams withdrawing will be fined an amount up to 20000/- which will be paid prior to the team's next match, whether in the same tournament or the subsequent one. Decision of the Tournament Committee would be final and binding in this regard. Teams trying to fix results between them, win / losses or goal difference deliberately and surreptitiously will be penalized by the Polo Tournament Committee either by a fine or denial of play in the same / next tournament. Teams must ensure they have adequate horse power to play through the entire tournament before putting up an entry.

18. **Holding and Return of Club.** Cups/Trophies won by teams cannot be taken by then unless approved by Polo Secy, 61 Cavalry subject to being returned by **01 Jan 2018** as these are rolling trophies.

19. **Final Decision.** The decision of tournament Committee will be final on all matters connected with a tournament. Please also note contents of IPA circular No IPA/22 dated 31<sup>st</sup> Jul 1993.

20. **Umpires and Referees.** As per IPA rules, no team can dispute the nomination of umpires/ referees as done by the Tournament Committee (IPA Rule g 7 (c) & (e)).

(a) **Umpires.**

(i) Based on Umpiring grade of players (approved by IPA) participating in the tournament (or those available and not playing), an Umpiring Panel approved by the Polo Tournament Committee. Preferably, for 10 goal tournaments, all matches will be officiated by Grade A Umpires only. In case adequate grade A umpires are not available, the tournament committee shall take the decision on considering the grade of umpires who shall officiate. Any player refusing to Umpire /Referee a match will be fined a sum of 5000/- and IPA will be intimated of the default for initiating suitable action.

(ii) **Turn Out of Umpires.** During all matches, umpires should be ready and should ride out to the centre of the ground five minutes before the game is due to start. Non-reporting of umpires or umpires reporting late for any game will be penalized by a fine of Rs 2000/- (Rupees two thousand only). The umpire will be banned to take part in the subsequent match / tournament until the umpire (s) of his /their team pays the fine at least one day before the team's next match. The tournament committee reserves the right to deduct the penalty amount from the security deposit/ amount due to team. The matter will also be reported to discipline committee IPA.

(iii) **Dress Code.** Umpires detailed for games must wear knee length brown boots and white breeches (IPA Rule G 11.2). To ensure safety measures, all umpires will be required to wear helmets (not soft caps) while umpiring. Defaulter will be fined Rs 1000/-.

(iv) **Provision of Mounts for the Umpires.** Responsibility to provide mounts to the umpires will be of the two teams playing in any given match. All playing teams will, therefore, bring additional horses for the umpires properly equipped in accordance with IPA field rules F4 (iii).

(v) Umpires will be present in riding boots for prize distribution.

(b) **Referee.** Coordinators of the Tournament will detail suitable Referees for all matches. As the task of the Referee in the game is very important, he should, on occasions when he feels that the umpiring is not up to the mark, call and brief the umpires any time, during or after the match. He is also at liberty to brief the umpires before the start of the match so as to ensure smooth conduct of the match.

21. **Substitution.** In case two teams are entered under the same name, change of players from one team to another will not be permitted. A minimum of three players will be entered in the team prior to draw. The total handicap of the three players of a team should meet the handicap requirement of the tournament. All rules of substitution will be as per rules of the IPA.
22. **Coggins and Glanders Test.** All rules and instructions issued from the IPA, Army HQ & Remount Veterinary Directorate on the subject will be strictly adhered to by all concerned. All horses will be tested for Coggins and glander before coming to participate in Jaipur Polo Season. A coggins negative certificate with a minimum of 25 days validity on arrival and exit of horses is mandatory. In addition, glanders test is mandatory requirement for all horse coming for Jaipur Polo Season 2017.
23. **Veterinary Commission.** A veterinary commission instituted for the Jaipur Polo Season will have full right to examine all the participating horses.
24. **Medical Cover.** The Chinkara Polo Club will provide medical cover for players at the ground. The Chinkara Polo Club shall not accept any liability for medical treatment given to players on the ground or the consequences thereof. In case of any injury or death to players, support staff and horses at the camping ground or during conduct of the game, the Chinkara Polo Club will not be responsible for any kind of compensation or claim whatsoever. Jaipur Polo Season 2017 being a voluntarily participating tournament, therefore it will be the responsibility of each team and players to settle the dispute or claim themselves. It will be the responsibility of the individual player and the team captain to give a written undertaking absolving the Club in any responsibility in this regard. Specimen of the declaration to be given by all playing members is enclosed as Appendix 'D'. The Chinkara Polo Club will provide first aid emergency treatment as well as evacuation to the hospital where necessary.
25. **Insurance Cover.** It is recommended that all players take insurance against any injury sustained while playing Polo on the Cavalry Polo ground.
26. **Dress Code.** Players and Umpires will be required to strictly adhere to the dress code on the field and during the prize distribution ceremony. All umpires mounts will have gaiters / bandages on all four legs. The Polo Tournament Committee reserves the right to take any suitable action against defaulter. No players is allowed to change into tract suits/ pants etc and come for prize distribution. Teams captains /patrons are requested to ensure the above. Umpires will wear helmets during the game. All teams will take approval of the colour for their team dress from Chinkara Polo Club at least 07 days prior to commencement of the tournament to prevent two teams wearing same colours.
27. **Environment Protection.** No one camping on allotted area is permitted to cut tree /brushes. Violation will be liable to prompt and severe action which may include forfeiting further participation in the season.

28. **Prize Distribution Ceremony.** To avoid undue delay and embarrassment to the Chief Guest and the sponsor, all players are requested to dismount on the ground itself after the finals of every tournament / Exhibition match and come straight for the prize distribution. The grooms can be directed to come on the ground to hold the horses. The players and Umpires are required to be in the proper polo attire.
29. **Arboriculture.** No Det/Camp will spoil or cut the environment. Immediate expulsion and action as per existing law will be enforced. No warning will be issued.
30. The tournament committee reserves the right to amend, add or delete any of the above terms and conditions.
31. **Facilities.**
- (a) Lodging and boarding for the service players only on payment charges as applicable.
- (b) **Tpt.** Suitable tpt arrngs are planned for mov of service teams and indl service players for matches, subject to availability and appropriate movement orders.
- (c) **Rail Freight.** Horses/ ponies and attendants of Polo team are entitled to rail concession as laid down Rule 101 (Ser No 31) of IRCA Coaching Tariff No 22 Part I (Volume II). Applications for rail concession is required to be sent to the Divisional Superintendent of the Railway concerned. Teams may kindly avail the form for 50% discount available for transportation of horses by train from the Indian Polo Association.
